3. <u>Education and Career Guidance (ECG) Bazaar on Tuesday, 5 November 2024.</u>

We will be having the ECG Bazaar for the Primary 5 and Primary 6 students on Tuesday, 5 November 2024. The objectives of the ECG Bazaar are to provide an opportunity for our students to

- Interact with the secondary school students and teachers to gather information about the schools they might be interested to apply for.
- Ask questions and find out more about the secondary school's programmes / CCAs, etc.

4. P3 and P4 Music Learning Journey to "The Princess and the Pea" on Wednesday, 6 November 2024 and Tuesday, 12 November 2024

As part of the music curriculum, the Primary 3 and 4 students will be embarking on a half-day learning journey within the curriculum time to watch the musical "The Princess and the Pea" by Singapore Repertory Theatre on Wednesday, 6 November 2024 and Tuesday, 12 November 2024.

This learning journey is one of the key Student Development Experiences for primary school students as it helps them to make connection in music. The students will understand the role of music in society: different roles in a music performance, appropriate behaviour in a performance context. This music learning journey will allow them to appreciate music from global cultures: Western classical tradition in local modern context.

5. <u>Issuance of Report Books on Monday, 11 November 2024 (P4) and Wednesday, 13 November 2024 (P1, P2, P3, P5)</u>

Report Books will be issued to Primary 4 students on Monday, 11 November 2024. Primary 4 students will receive the Option Forms to select their subject combinations for Primary 5 in 2025. All Report Books and Option Forms must be returned to the Form Teachers on Wednesday, 13 November 2024.

Primary 1, Primary 2, Primary 3 and Primary 5 students will receive their Report Books on Wednesday, 13 November 2024. Report Books must be returned to the 2025 Form Teacher on Friday, 3 January 2025.



6. Promotion Day on Wednesday, 13 November 2024

Promotion Day is an annual exercise held on the last day of school to promote students to their new 2025 classes. Before they move on to their new classes, students will have time to reflect and take stock of what they have done for the year with their teachers and classmates.
